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# MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT GENERAL CRISIS INTERVENTION

HOTLINE	HOURS	DESCRIPTION
Community Crisis Action Team (C-CAT) by Family Service League 1-888-FSL-CCAT or 1-888-375-2228	24/7	This C-CAT team responds to traumatic incidents, assessing the needs of individuals and groups who have experienced a critical event in the workplace, school or community. C-CAT is often deployed within hours of first contact and uses debriefings, defusing and one-on-one intervention to help mitigate the impact of traumatic situations. Conexión Spanish Hotline by Response Crisis Center 631-751-7423	M-F 5-10PM	Conexión is a bilingual hotline serving the Hispanic community by providing telephone support for people in crisis. Calls may be about any challenge, such as making a home in a new country, forming friendships, finding work, struggling with depression and many others. Conexión counselors provide referrals to bilingual services as necessary.  SERVES SPANISH SPEAKING SUFFOLK RESIDENTS
DASH (Diagnostic, Assessment, and Stabilization Hub) / Suffolk Mobile Crisis by Family Service League (631) 952-3333	24/7	DASH is a 27/7/365 voluntary program for individuals in crisis who are feeling overwhelmed due to substance use, mental illness and/or other life stressors. The program provides assessment, stabilization and linkage to care. The program also features mobile crisis teams and 24/7 crisis notline.  SERVES SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS

Middle Earth Hotline by Long Island Crisis Center (516) 679-1111	24/7	Middle Earth Hotline was Long Island Crisis Center's first hotline. Crisis intervention and suicide prevention counseling are available; counselors also provide information and referrals.  SERVES NASSAU AND SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS
Nassau County Behavioral Health Helpline/ Mobile Crisis Intervention Team (516) 227-TALK (8255)	Everyday 10AM- 11PM	The Nassau County Behavioral Health Helpline provides short-term crisis intervention counseling and support. This Helpline also serves as the intake department for the county's Mobile Crisis Unit. The helpline will guarantee that clients struggling with mental health and/or substance abuse issues can get support and direction when they decide they are ready – any time – day or night.  The Mobile Crisis team consists of licensed professional social workers and nurses who are specially trained to provide supportive crisis intervention for individuals, and their families, who are experiencing an emotional disturbance, interpersonal crisis or psychiatric emergency. The team responds same-day and can travel to homes, schools, work-sites and other Nassau County locations.  SERVES NASSAU COUNTY RESIDENTS
Response Support Line by Response Crisis Center (631) 751-7500	24/7	Professionally trained and supervised counselors offer callers telephone support and help them explore options that allow them to think through their next steps. This counseling helps callers lower their anxiety and find their own solutions. Crisis counselors also provide referrals for support groups, clinicians, mental health clinics, other hotlines and other community programs and services.  SERVES SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS

Joe's Project by Family Service League 1-888-FSL-CCAT or 1-888-375-2228	24/7	Joe's Project provides suicide prevention and postvention support to individuals, families, and group counseling, as well as support to organizations and communities affected by the loss of someone who died by suicide.  SERVES NASSAU AND SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS
LIRR Suicide Hotline 1 (877) 582-5586	24/7	Provides suicide prevention services on a dedicated telephone hotline advertised at LIRR train stations and platforms for callers who are in emotional distress or feeling suicidal. Callers connect with trained counselors who can provide immediate assistance and referral to support services or emergency intervention.  SERVES NASSAU AND SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS
Middle Earth Hotline by Long Island Crisis Center (516) 679-1111	24/7	Middle Earth Hotline was Long Island Crisis Center's first hotline. OASAS HOPEline by NYSOPDV 1-877-8-HOPENY (467369) or text HOPENY	24/7	Individuals may call or text the HOPEline to receive free and confidential information about Addiction and problem gambling assessments, interventions, treatment and support in New York State. The HOPEline is staffed by specially trained and supervised mental health professionals with training in addiction and people with lived addiction experience or peer advocates that are available at the request of the caller. HOPEline provides Crisis Intervention Support, including de-escalation and collaboration to connect to 911. HOPEline staff utilize the OASAS Resource Map Tool, to provide callers with a wide range of referral sources.  SERVES NASSAU AND SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS
Suffolk County Substance Abuse Hotline by SCDOH and LICADD (631) 979-1700	24/7	The Suffolk County Department of Health Services has partnered with the Long Island Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence (LICADD) to operate a 24/7 hotline that will connect callers to treatment services. LICADD works collaboratively with the Suffolk County Communities of Solution (COS) provider network to ensure timely access to quality substance abuse care.  SERVES SUFFOLK COUNTY RESIDENTS

Against Domestic Violence is standing by to help. Call to reach one of our in-house, trained domestic violence counselors. You will never reach an answering machine or be charged a fee. This includes arranging emergency safe housing, providing information about reporting abuse and accessing forensic medical care, and linking callers to the agency's full spectrum of services and other community-based resources.
