Children 7+ and adults- The test can typically be completed in 1 session of 90 minutes. If further testing is needed, we will make an appointment on a second day.
Before the test
Do not stop any medications.
The patient should be well rested.
For children you may bring a snack and drink should he/she require a break during testing.
The Test
Words, numbers, sentences and tones will be presented through ear phones in a variety of listening conditions. Your child will be instructed on how to respond.

Billing and Insurance
