Preparation for Esophageal Manometry

- 1. At least 24 Hours BEFORE the procedure:
 - ❖ **STOP** the following medications (if you are taking them for your stomach and esophageal problems):
 - Nitrates (Nitroglycerin, Nitropatches, pastes, Isosorbide Dinitrate)
 - Calcium channel-blocking agents (Nifedipine, Verapamil, Diltiazem)
 - Anticholinergics (Propantheline)
 - Promotility agents (Metoclopramide, Benanechol)
 - Muscle relaxants (Diazepam, Tizanidine, ect.)
 - Narcotics (Opiates)
 - Anti-Anxiety medications (Diazepam, Xanax, Ativan, etc.)
 - **❖** You may continue to take your heart medication.
- 2. SIX (6) HOURS BEFORE: **DO NOT** eat or drink anything.
- 3. DAY OF TEST:
 - Stop at Patient Registration in the ACP building on Level 2 before proceeding to the GI Motility Center.
 - ❖ If you have a prescription order form, please bring it with you.
- **4.** Please be prepared to spend about 1.5 hour in the Motility Center.
- 5. You do not need anyone to accompany you to this appointment.
