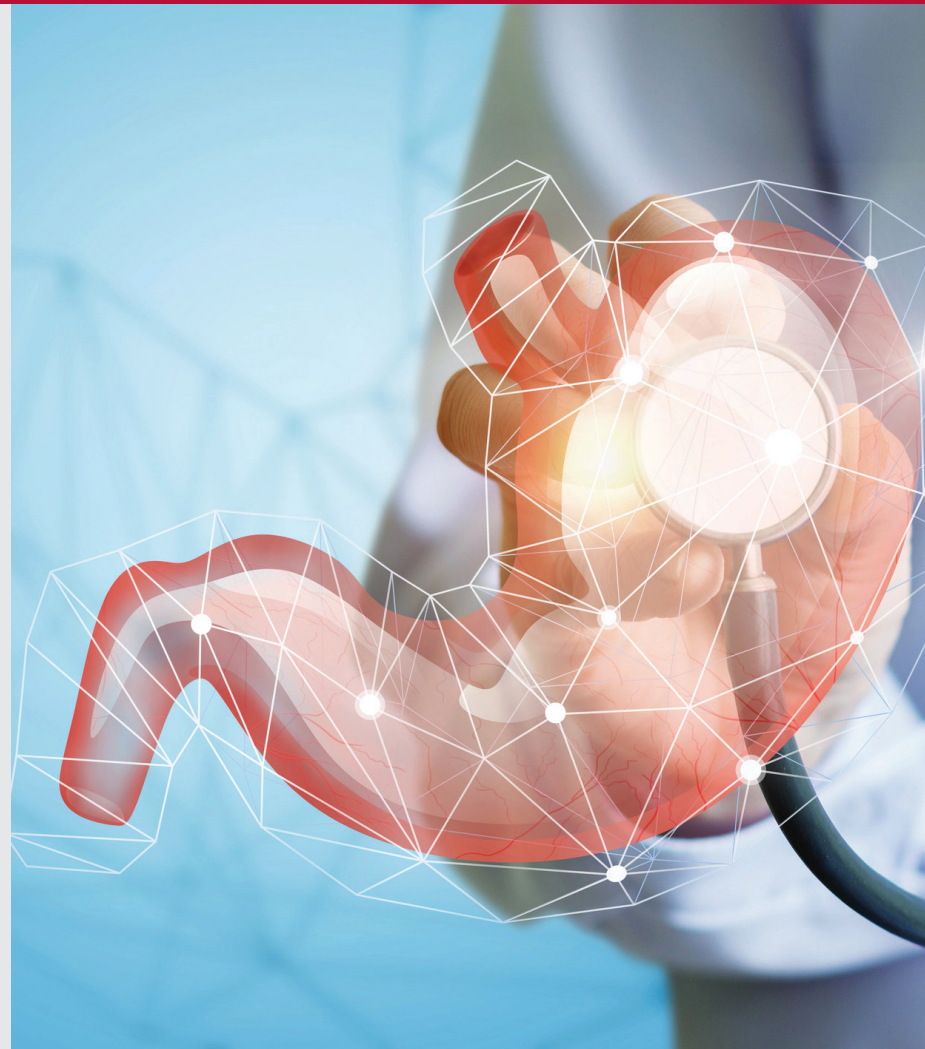


COURSE DESCRIPTION

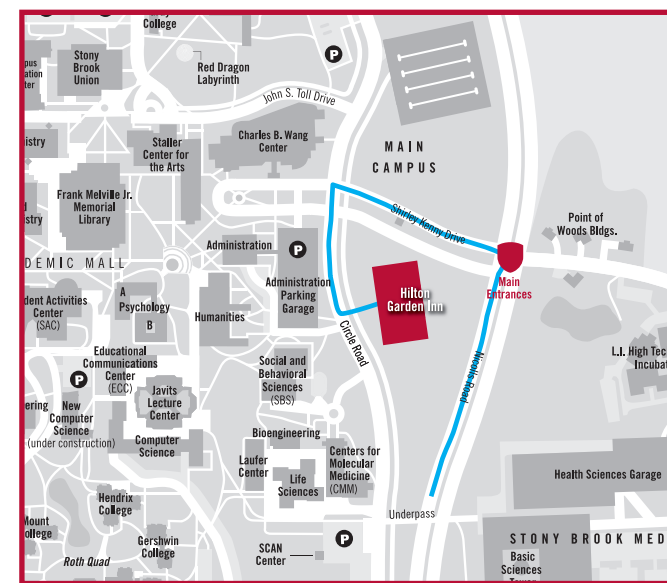

The topics that will be presented make up a large percentage of the common complaints medical professionals face and are also a cause of significant morbidity. We aim with this conference to provide clinical pearls as well as updates on the latest diagnostic tools, therapeutic agents, and research data available on a wide breadth of motility disorders. This will include the latest recommendations for diagnosis and treatment of esophageal, gastric, small bowel, colon, and anorectal conditions, including but not limited to GERD, major esophageal motility disorders, gastroparesis, small intestinal bacterial overgrowth, IBS, constipation, and fecal incontinence.

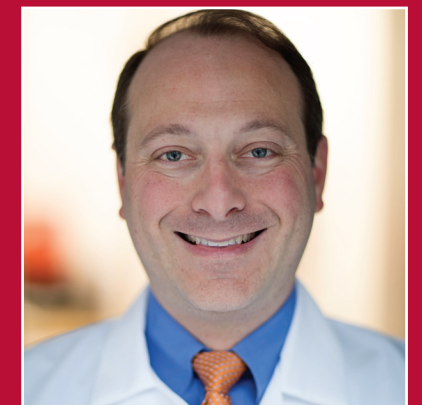
